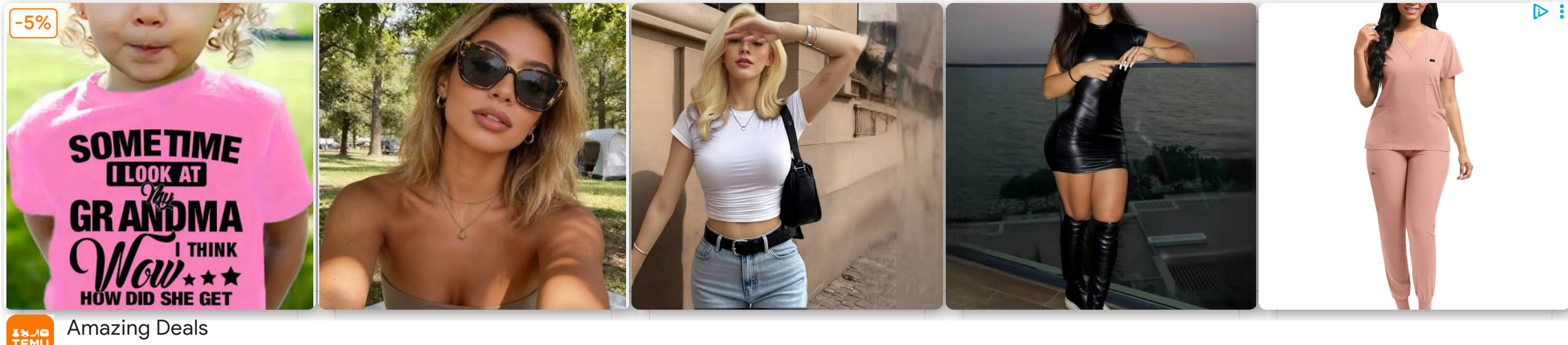


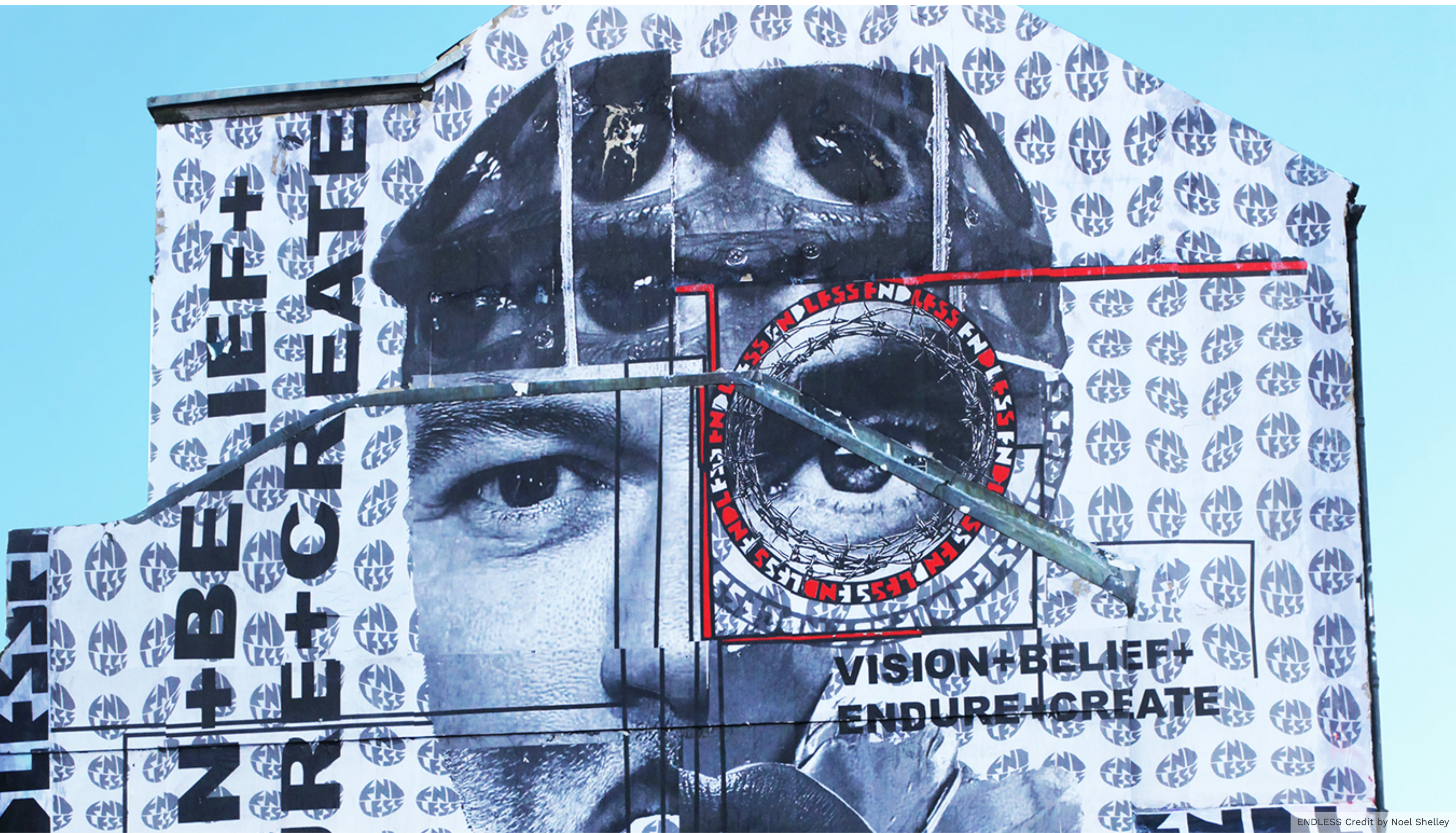

Endless Unveils Monumental Brighton Mural Championing Creativity and Cultural Collaboration

The artist ENDLESS's new work, created with actor Luke Evans, brings contemporary art and personal narrative to the centre of Brighton's public realm in the form of a striking new mural

On 1 December, British artist **ENDLESS**, mentored by the legendary duo Gilbert & George, will reveal a commanding new mural in central **Brighton**, a work conceived to press home a clear message: creativity matters.

The large-scale piece centres on a carefully constructed portrait that merges the artist's own features with those of acclaimed actor **Luke Evans**. Their combined likeness forms the focal point of a composition anchored by the slogan "**VISION. BELIEF. ENDURE. CREATE.**" It reads as a stark reminder that creative practice, whether on canvas or stage, requires conviction and a willingness to stand firm when the odds are unforgiving.

Speaking about the collaboration, Luke Evans said: "It's a monumental artwork that I am incredibly proud to be a part of. I believe wholeheartedly in the message Endless is conveying through his unique style. I have no doubt this mural will serve as a beacon of hope and an energising call to the creative spirit that lives within us all."

The collaboration between **ENDLESS** and Evans began after the pair met at the opening of the **Gilbert & George** exhibition in London. Drawn to Evans' varied trajectory, from his accomplished film career to the launch of his fashion brand BDXY, Endless recognised parallels with his own beginnings. The artist noted that Evans' rise from modest roots made his presence within the mural both intuitive and symbolically charged.

ENDLESS' practice has long threaded together social observation, contemporary culture and the visual language of consumerism. After graduating from the Cambridge School of Art, he took his ideas to the streets of London, where his distinctive graphic clarity drew the attention of galleries, global brands and collectors. His ongoing exploration of modern reverence, consumer desire and celebrity worship frequently appears through his recurring "Chapel" motif, a reimagined Chanel No. 5 bottle that casts brand culture as a modern form of devotion.

Across his career, ENDLESS has marked several significant firsts. In 2021, he became the first street artist to have work included in the Medici collection at Le Gallerie degli Uffizi, donating a self-portrait created with Gilbert & George. A year later, he represented the Republic of San Marino at La Biennale Arte, the first street artist ever to exhibit at the event. His commissions for cultural institutions and major brands include a 50th anniversary tribute to British Punk at Liberty London and a mural honouring The Beatles' "Abbey Road" outside the iconic recording studio.

ENDLESS' work is currently on view at **Indelible Gallery** in Brighton. The unveiling of the mural will be covered by the **BBC** and **ITV News**, marking another milestone for an **artist** intent on placing contemporary art and public culture in direct conversation.
